Junior Research and Teaching Fellow 2017/2018

Deadline: April 30, 2017

The Center for German Studies intends to appoint a Junior Research and Teaching Fellow for 6 months. The fellow is expected to conduct research and to teach in English a 4-credit point course during one semester on one of the following topics:

Germany after 1945 | Germany and the EU | Germany and Israel

Priority will be given to courses focusing on modern German Federalism and the German Political Party System.

- Applications are invited from postdoctoral scholars with an excellent research record.
- The stipend will be 2,500 € per month.
- The successful candidate will be provided with work space at the Center for German Studies, and will have full access to the research facilities at the Hebrew University.

The application should contain the following documents:

1. CV & List of publications
2. Course proposal for a 4 credit point course (26 academic hours)
3. Description of the research project, its purpose and anticipated results (max. 2 pages)
